### Re: Vancouver Janitorial Labour Gap Study

The BC Contract Cleaners Association has retained an independent industry consultant to conduct a survey of wages paid in various entry level employment categories. The survey will be similar to one done in June 2006 by the Calgary Contract Cleaners Association in conjunction with BOMA Calgary and will provide data and analysis of competing semi-skilled occupational groups (fast-food, hotel, retail and general construction labour).

The goal of the survey is to establish a benchmark for wages and benefits in the janitorial industry that will help contract cleaners compete in a tight labour market and ultimately reverse the trend of trained workers leaving the industry. The full scope of the project can be found in the attached November 21, 2006 letter.
